### Mode of school and curricula :-

K.P.S. Memorial public school impart education in English media with importance to National language Hindi. The school follows C.B.S.E. Curricula including in its educational programme ample Co-curricular activities like public speaking, debates, declamations, poem recitation, dramatics, music, painting, photography, study of electronics and computers.

### Registration and Admission:-

Registration and admission forms are available on payment of rupees 500/- at the school counter.

### Admission Rules :-

- 1.Registration does not mean guarantee of admission. Admission is granted only after an admission test and personal interview with the child and the parents.
- 2.If a child is found fit for admission which should be accepted within two days and the guardian must deposit the admission form, required fee and previous school leaving certificate.
- 3 Admission is only confirmed on fulfilling all above conditions.



### Agreement

Every parents should execute an agreement prescribed by the school which he will receive along with the admission form. Admission will not be granted unless the agreement is executed.

### Admission Test

Admission test will be held at K.P.S.M.P.S. and the final interview will be conducted at the same place. Two hours objective test for admission will be given in the subjects of general Awareness, Hindi, Maths, English and General Science. The sample question papers will be available on payment. The Syllabus will be as per NCERT standard for these Classes.

### Parents Visit

Parents and other authorised guardians may visit their wards in the campus on not more than twice in a month i.e. Saturday.

It is imperative that parents are familiarized with the way of the school so that it becomes easy for them to get accustomed and for the child to acclimatize with environment of the school.

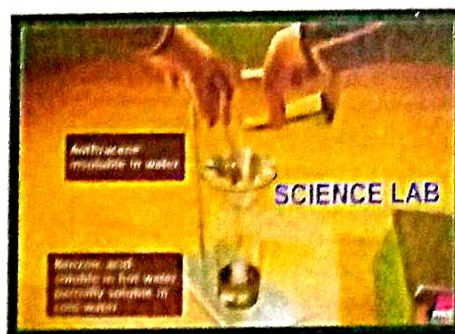

## General Instruction

1. School Fee is payable quarterly at the office counter or in the corporation Bank Ac name K.P.S.M.P. SCHOOL (Ac no 134500101002060) Amethi in advance by the 10th of the said month.

2. If Fee is not payed in time a fine of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged up to the end of the month after which the student's name will be granted only if there is vacancy in the class and a re-admission fee will be charged.

3. If a student attends school even for a single day, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the full month.

4. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
